ORDER

Sub.: Election of Krishi Vikas Bahu Rajya Sahkari Samiti Limited-reg.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 45K (1) of the Multi State Co-operative Societies (MSCS), Act 2002 (as amended from time to time) read with rule 19F (a) of the MSCS Rules, 2002, the Co-operative Election Authority (CEA), appointed District Magistrate, Gautam Budh Nagar, as Returning Officer (RO) on 18.12.2024 for conduct of Elections of Krishi Vikas Bahu Rajya Sahkari Samiti Limited and also issued the Election program from 16.01.2025 to 19.02.2025.

2. The Returning Officer submitted Format 19 M under the Rule 19M (1) of MSCS Rules vide his letter dated 07.02.2025 for seeking approval of the Cooperative Election Authority for Board of Directors of the above-mentioned society under the Rule 19M (1) of MSCS Rules.
3. The Authority examined the recommendation and observed that there is no clarity in number of directors to be elected as per Bye-Laws no. 31 (a) to (g). Also, it is not clear as how to count SC/ST and Women Members in overall limit of 5 directors, per state. In the instant case, 7 directors have been recommended by RO (which include women candidates) from one state (U.P).
4. Considering the available material on record, the Authority has decided not to accept the recommendation of RO as contained in Form 19M and decided to issue fresh election schedule.
