

2. **Eligibility Conditions, Period of deputation and List of duties / responsibilities:** Details are at Annexure I-IV.

3. **Regulation of pay and other terms of deputation:** - The pay and allowances and other terms and conditions governing the deputation in respect of the selected candidate will be regulated under the provisions contained in the Department of Personal & Training O.M.No. 6/8/2009-Estt. (Pay-II) dated 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2010, as amended from time to time.

4. **Age-limit:** - The maximum age-limit for appointment on deputation (including short term contract) shall not exceed 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of application.
