Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to your letter no. RO/JCCS-BOD/Election/2025-2030/14 dated 27.11.2025 regarding ensuring reservation of seats for women (2) & SC/ST (1) as per Bye-Laws no. 31(B)(i) and to say that the Authority has considered your proposal and acceded to the suggestion. Accordingly, election may continue and the contesting candidates may be from the respective constituency as per Bye-Laws no. 31 (v) of the Society.

2. The counting of votes for the reserved seats should be taken up first, and reserved candidates receiving maximum votes through voting across all constituencies may be recommended as elected member from the constituency to which they belong. Thereafter, the number of seats be readjusted in that constituency by reducing the seats from where Women & SC/ST candidates have secured maximum votes.
