**ORDER**

(Under sub-section (4) of Section 84 of the Multi State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002)

Whereas, an arbitration dispute under Section 84 of the Multi-State Co-operative Societies Act, 2002 in the matter of Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative Limited (IFFCO) Vs. M/s Chinatamani Taluk Agriculture Produce Coop Marketing Society Ltd. was referred to Dr. T. Philip Thanglienmang, Sole Arbitrator, vide this office order dated 18.06.2024.

2. And whereas, IFFCO vide letter dated 20.03.2026 has informed that the arbitral proceedings have remained stalled for a prolonged period and the Arbitrator is reportedly untraceable at the available address, resulting in non-conduct of proceedings despite repeated requests made by the claimant;

3. And whereas, an application under Section 84(1)(c) of the Multi-State Co-operative Societies Act, 2002 has also been received from IFFCO in the matter relating to alleged financial irregularities committed by Shri Umang Parmar, Guwahati, Assam;

4. And whereas, the matters have been examined and it is considered appropriate in the interest of justice and expeditious disposal of disputes to appoint a common Sole Arbitrator in both the matters;

5. Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 84 of the Multi-State Co-operative Societies Act, 2002, this authority hereby appoints Shri Avinash Shukla, Editor (Deputy Secretary), Ministry of Law and Justice, as Sole Arbitrator in the following matters:

(i) IFFCO Vs. M/s Chinatamani Taluk Agriculture Produce Coop Marketing Society Ltd. — in place of Dr. T. Philip Thanglienmang;

(ii) IFFCO Vs. Shri Umang Parmar, Guwahati, Assam.

6. The learned Arbitrator shall enter upon reference and conduct the proceedings in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and

Conciliation Act, 1996 and the provisions of the MSCS Act, 2002 and rules made thereunder.

7. The parties to the disputes are directed to appear before the learned Arbitrator on such date, time and venue as may be fixed by him.

8. The above appointments are **valid for one year** with effect from the date of issue of this order.
