Subject: Removal of Chairperson, Manarang Manufacturing Multistate Industrial Cooperative Society Ltd., purportedly by passing a No-Confidence Resolution - Show-cause Notice.

Reference: Your letter Ref. No. MMMICS/CEO/2026/21 dated 21.06.2026 and Board Resolution No. mmmcis_002/2026 dated 26.06.2026.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the communication cited above addressed to Central Registrar of Cooperative Society whereby it has been intimated that Shri A. Lakshminarayanan, Chairperson of the society has been removed by passing a No-Confidence Resolution and that new office bearers were thereafter elected/appointed.

2. Removal of the Chairperson of a duly elected Board of a society is a serious issue and has to conform to the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002 and the rules framed thereunder in addition to Bye-laws of the society.

3. Accordingly, the Society is directed to furnish following information:

- (i) Notice for convening the meeting, agenda, proof of service upon all concerned members for No-Confidence Resolution;
- (ii) The precise grounds for moving and passing the Resolution, including each act, omission, deficiency or failure attributed to the Chairperson;
- (iii) certified copies of Proceedings and minutes of the meeting, attendance, quorum, voting details and record of any objection, dissent or abstention;
- (iv) Whether the individual was informed in advance along with grounds of No-confidence motion and a reasonable opportunity to explain his stand / being heard was afforded; copies of the notice, explanation received and hearing record shall also be enclosed.

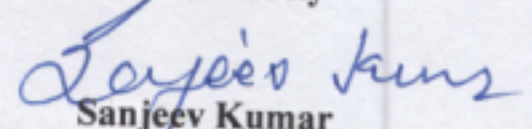
3.1 Further, the Bye-laws of the society may be referred (which have been relied upon) and the copy of the same may be provided.

4. As regards, appointment/election of the Chairperson, it is stated that the cardinal principle is that it is the appointing authority, who has the powers to appoint successor in case of Casual Vacancy. As per Section 45J (5) of the multi-state co-operative societies Act, 2002, the term of the

elected member of the Board and its office bearers shall be 5 years from the date of election and the term of office bearer shall be co-terminus with the term of the Board. Any vacancy arising, it has been provided in the proviso has to be filled by the Cooperative Election Authority except in case of Board of Directors up to the 1/3rd of the total strength of the Board that too from the same class.

5. You are requested to reply within 15 days of the receipt of this letter.
